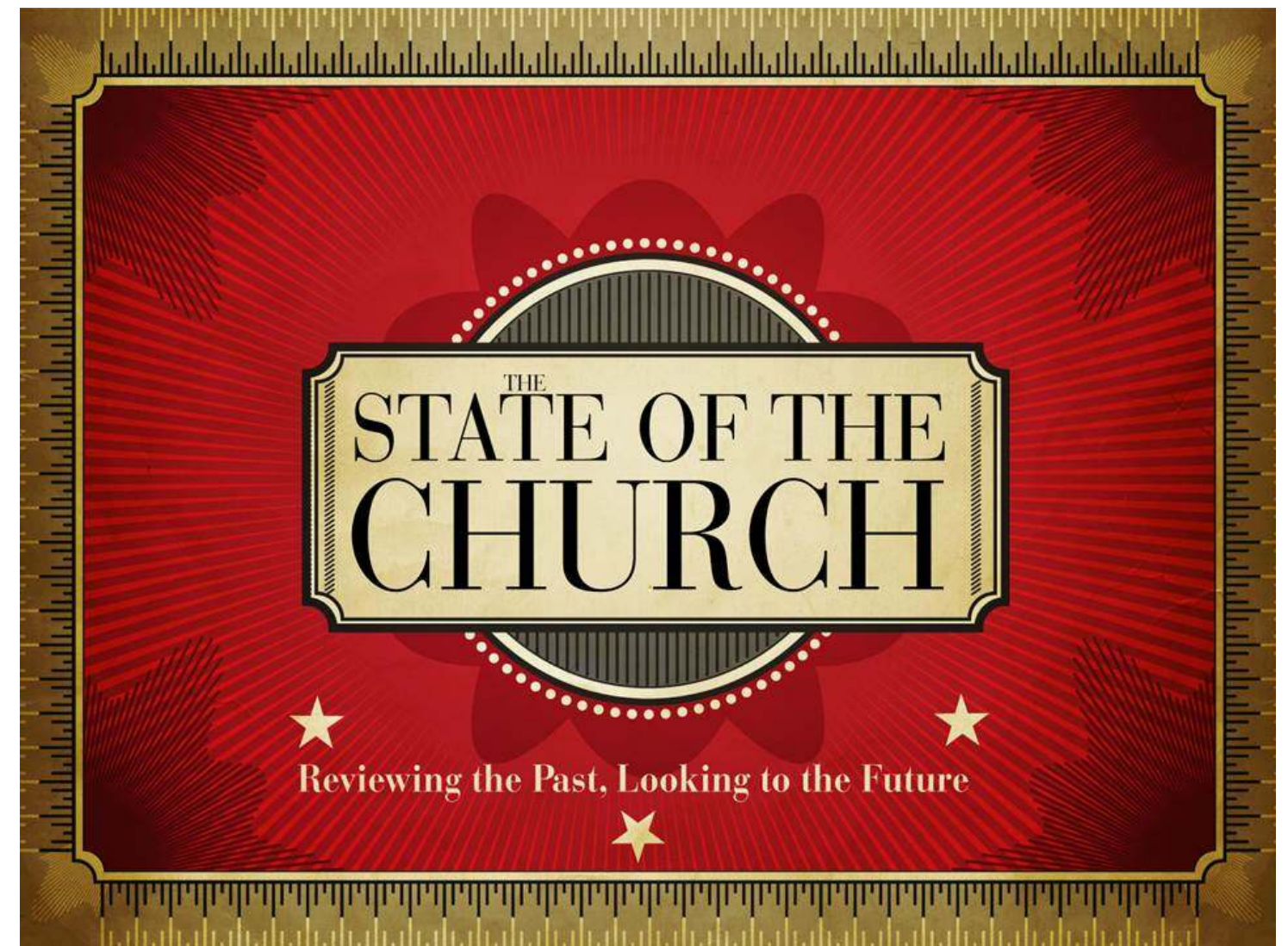

We have finished chapter one and will begin chapter two this morning. In this chapter John recorded the message of Jesus to the seven churches of Asia. The twenty-one letters of the new Testament are messages to the various congregations. This last book would be the last letter to the people of God from Jesus Christ. Written during a time of great persecution of the church, Revelation was a tremendous source of comfort and encouragement to the first century Christians. It is a good idea to study each chapter of the book, so you will be better prepared to understand our discussions each Sunday morning.

I am very grateful for each member at Broadway. Each member is important to God and to one another. Please remember, "Know that the Lord Himself is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; We are His people and the sheep of His pasture" (Psalm 100:3, NASV).

Loving God Takes Work

We are to love God with all of our heart, strength, soul, and mind. However it seems hard sometimes. Why is that? The reason is simple; we give our love to other things. We often give our hearts to people, spouses, and our children. We often times make others our priority without considering our first love (Rev. 2:4) I know I often feel worn out. We feel at times we don't have strength to even make it through the day. We feel we don't have the strength to love God the way we should. When the soulful love we should have for God isn't there the reason is we are bonded to other things. We choose friendships with the world (James 4:4). We give our bond to work, sports, school, and other interests. We do this without remembering that God is a jealous God (Ex. 20:5). When our minds are not devoted to loving God it is because our minds are consumed with other things. We fill our minds with such useless information. We mindlessly watch TV, scroll through social media hours on end, play video games, etc. When we come home from a hard day's work our minds are often consumed with the problems of the day.

If we are going to love God with all our hearts, strength, souls, and minds we are going to have to be dedicated to the task of loving Him. We need to rekindle our love and adoration for God. We need to spend time in prayer and meditation (Ps. 1:2). We need to spend time pouring our hearts out to our Father in heaven. We need to ask Him for strength and be strengthened from the nourishment of His Word (John 6:33). We need to remove some of the bonds we have in this life to be able to love Him with all of our soul. We need to remove any bond that would separate us from the love of God (Mt.10:34). And finally if we are to love God with all of our minds we need to renew our mind through God's word (Rom. 12:2). However if our mind is being filled to capacity with useless things there won't be enough room for God's word to penetrate. We must remove some of the trash that clutters our mind if we are going to love God in the way he demands.
